<u>"Fix a Leak Week"</u> is March 15-21st and brochures will be available. The District has several water conservations links that are on the District's website. Remember "Water, please Use It Wisely"!

DUE TO THE CORONAVIRUS, WE WILL EXTEND OUR CELEBRATION OF "FIX A LEAK WEEK".

Do you suspect a leak? If so, do the following:

- 1. Check all the connections where the water comes into your home, under sinks, behind toilets, at the washing machine and hot water heater. If there is water or corrosion, please repair at once as all leaks can be costly.
- 2. Check the toilet for silent leaks with food coloring dye drops in tank and see if colored water comes up in the toilet bowl. Repair if the colored dye appears in the bowl. If the toilet is old, replace with a WaterSense Efficient toilet. If you are certain it is a leak outside of your home, please call the office customer service number listed on the front of your bill or on this newsletter.
