**OFS Solid Waste Services, Inc.**, is the trash provider here in Cloverleaf. This is for household trash only. Household garbage does NOT include remodeling or garage sales waste. All household trash should be bagged or in cans, not exceeding 40 gallons or 40 pounds. Trash must be at curbside by 7:00 a.m. on Wednesdays and Saturdays. For other types of heavy trash pickup service please contact **OFS** directly for a price and payment arrangements. Any questions or problems concerning trash service or pick up contact **OFS** at 281-457-2705.

The best method of payment for your water bill is automatic bank draft, check, or money order, at no cost to the customer. An authorization form will need to be signed for automatic bank draft along with a voided check to activate this service. Your monthly bill will still be mailed at the same time, and the bill will reflect "this amount will be drafted from your account by due date". By doing the automatic bank draft it is always paid by the due date and no penalties will be added. The District does accept Master Card and Visa cards however, a service fee is added for using credit cards.

"Fix a Leak Week" is March 18-24, 2013 and we encourage all residents to check for any leaks. Check all faucets for drips, check toilets for silent leaks and make sure all outside faucets are tight and do not drip. A small drip can increase your water consumption and increase your water bill. Please remember to be "Water Smart" and for any information or questions, please contact the office! There is water conservation pamphlets available in the office.

Please report any street light outages to our office with the street address of the outage and the 6 digit number listed on the light pole. The lights have a 6 foot arm extending out over the streets.

The District has a limit of connections per lot. "Meaning only one living unit is allowed per lot". You must have permits before replacing water or wastewater lines and the District must file an inspection report on this work before the pipe is covered up.
